

MAIL OF THE SECRET POLICE

BACKGROUND The Portuguese Political Police (PIDE) had functioned with great power during the dictatorship of Samosa and later. It was dismantled following the revolution of 25th April 1974 Although strong, they tended to send trouble makers to the Colonies rather than

exterminante them. Many disitants ended up in Timor and the African Colonies.
