

# Angola

## LOCAL REPUBLICA OVERPRINT. 1914 - Congo

### ISSUE

As in Angola, a local san-serif "REPUBLICA" overprint in red or green was applied to old stamp stocks held in Angola, stock which had not as yet been overprinted. The overprinting was done in Luanda, Angola, in order to use up the stock. Issued with or without gum. The set was commonly used.

### ERRORS

Again, as with the Angola overprints, a large quantity of printer's waste hit the market due to poor supervision. Errors include misplaced, inverted, doubled and wrongly coloured overprint. A number of inverted and displaced letters are found in the "REPUBLICA" overprints. The three broken "5" errors are found on the 50/75 Carlos stamp.

### NOT REGULARLY LISTED

A sheet of 75 violet, with the value 15, instead of 75, was overprinted with the required green "REPUBLICA" overprint. This is a highly sought after error. Not as rare, but unlisted, is the 75 rose without the "PROVISORIO" overprint, found with green and rarely the purple REPUBLICA overprint
