

## LOCAL SURCHARGES 1945-1946

### ISSUE

Due to a shortage of low value stamps in Angola a surcharging of higher value issues was undertaken in Luanda Angola.

### ERRORS

The overprinting was poor in both positioning and print producing many printing errors - doubled, inverted and misplaced overprints are common and are best classified as printer's waste. Of particular interest is the use of damaged print bars, and letter displacement as well as an inverted "S" in CENTAVOS.
