FOURTH CENTENARY OF SAO PAULO. 1954

ISSUE.

Revaluation of the currency to Escudos. The stamp features the founder of the mission of Sao Paulo, Father M.de Nobrega, as well as a view of the modern city of Luanda. Sao Paulo de Luanda was established by Paulo Dias de Novas in 1576 and became the capital of Angola and of Luanda district. It later became the administrative centre for the colony and the main outlet for slaves to Brazil. This stamp was issued in all 8 colonies in different colours. Print run 2,000,000.

PRESIDENTIAL VISIT. 1954

ISSUE.

The stamp celebrates President Francisco H. C. Lopes's visit to the African colonies. It shows the route of his tour. Print run 5c 1,000,000, 4.50e 500,000. Issued May 27.

ANGOLAN TERRITORIAL MAP. 1955

ISSUE.

The issue displays a map of the Angolan territory. It was printed in colour, litho, and was designed by J. de Moura. Print run 2 to 5 million. Issued in August 55.

ERRORS.

Some printer's waste found its way onto the market representing different colour trials. There is a major colour shift found on the 4e stamp of dark blue instead of light blue.
