FOURTH CENTENARY OF SAO PAULO. 1954

ISSUE. Revaluation to Escudos. The stamp features the founder of mission of Sao Paulo, Father M. de Nobrega, as well as a view of the modern city of Luanda. Sao Paulo de Luanda was established by Paulo Dias de Novais in 1576 and became the capital of Angola and of Luanda district. It later became the administrative center for the colony and the main outlet for slaves to Brazil.
