Duarte Bridge, Oliveira Salazar Bridge And Captain S. Carvalho Bridge. Designed by I. Sastkovits and C. Rocha. Printed Litho.

40th ANNIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL REVOLUTION. 1966

ISSUE. The issue celebrates the 40th anniversary of the National Revolution in 1926 when a military revolt unseated the democratically elected government of 1925. By July 1926 Marshal Carmona had taken power of the provisional military government and remained in control until his death in 1951. A common colonial issue showing National buildings. The Angolan issue shows St. Paul's Hospital in Luanda and the Sarmiento Rodrigues Commercial and Industrial School. Designed by A. Cutileiro and Printed Litho.

ISSUE. The issue celebrates the centenary of the Holy Ghost Society. The issue shows the emblem of the society.

Errors, known with inscription omitted and inscription displaced sideways.

350th ANNIVERSARY OF BENGUELA. 1967

ISSUE. The issue commemorates the the 350th anniversary of the founding of Benguela, formally known as Sao Filipe de Benguela, which city serves as the capital of the Benguela district, western Angola. The city developed around the Sao Filipe fortress which was one of the bases for Portuguese expansion in Africa. The stamp illustrates the explorer Manuel Carveira over an old map of Angola.
