Production by Photo Coursoisier. Birds in natural colours. A rather scarce set. The actual birds in ascending order of value, firstly horizontal format: Racquet tailed roller, Bateleur, Bee-eater, Scissor-billed skimmer, South African skikra, Long-tailed shrike, white-crowned shrike, Sulphur-breasted bush shrike. Vertical format: Giant kingfisher, Yellow-headed baret, African openbill, Ground hornbill, Barrow's bustard, African golden oriole, Red glassy starling, Wedge-tailed glossy starling, Red-shouldered widow bird, Half-collared kingfisher, White-winged babbling starling, Yellow-billed hornbill Violet-backed starling, Secretary bird, Rosy-faced love-bird. Print run 1,000,000 to 200,000. Issued January 23 through to May 27.

Animals in ascending order: Leopard, Sable Antelope, African Elephant, Eland, Crocodile, Impala, Mountain zebra, Sitatunga, Black rhinoceros, Gernsbok, Lion, African buffalo, Springbok, Blue wildebeest, Hartebeest, Warthog, Waterbuck, Hippopotamus, Greater kudu, Giraffe. Print run 250,000 to 3,000,000. Issued August 15.

FORGERIES

The 20c elephant is known with a forged colour. Colour changes have been worked on this and other stamps using chemicals such as Turpentine, Xylene, Acetone and Chloroform.
