40th ANNIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL REVOLUTION. 1966

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the 40th anniversary of the National Revolution in 1926 when a military revolt unseated the democratically elected government of 1925. By July 1926 Marshal Carmona had taken power of the provisional military government and remained in control until his death in 1951. A common colonial issue showing National buildings. The Angolan issue shows St. Paul's Hospital in Luanda and the Sarmiento Rodrigues Commercial and Industrial School. Designed by A. Cutileiro and Printed Litho. Print run, 300,000. Issued May 28.

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the centenary of the Holy Ghost Society. The issue shows the emblem of the society. Print run 100,000. Issued August 15.

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the centenary of Portugal's Navy Club. The issue is common to all colonies. The Angolan issues show M. Barata and the Cruiser Don Carlos I, and A de Castilho and the corvette Mindelo. Design by A. Cutileiro and printed Litho Litografia Nacional, Oporto. Print run 200,000 each stamp. Issued January 31.

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the 50th anniversary of the apparition of the Virgin Mary to the three shepherd children at Fatima. The issue is common to all colonies with the Angolan issue showing the Fatima Basilica. Design by J. de Moura, and printed Litho. Errors, known with inscription omitted and inscription displaced sideways. Print run, 1,000,000. Issued May 13.
