The city developed around the Sao Filipe fortress which was one of the bases for Portuguese expansion in Africa. The stamp illustrates the explorer Manuel Carveira over an old map of Angola. In ascending values: The ribbon of the Three Orders, Military order of Avis, Military Order of Christ, Military Order of St. John of Espada, Order of the Empire, Order of Prince Henry, Order of Benemerencia, Order of Public Instruction and the Order for Industrial and Agricultural Merit.
