The issue celebrates the 500th birth anniversary of Pedro Cabral, explorer. Pedro Alvares Cabral was born in 1467 and, as well African navigation, he is the first European to have discovered Brazil. The issue is common to all 7 colonies, all with different designs. The Angolan issues displays Belmonte castle, St. Jeronimo's hermitage and Cabral's fleet. Design by Moura, printed Litho Litografia Maia, Oporto. Issued on April 22. Print run, 10,000,000 to 12,000,000.

BICENTENARY OF THE CITY OF NOVO REDONDO. 1969

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the bicentenary of the city of Novo Redondo which serves as the port capital of the Cuanza Sul district and lies on the Rio Gunza river. The stamp illustrates the founder, Fransico Inocencio de Souza Coutinho. Design by Moura and printed by Litho Litografia Maia, Oporto. Issued January 7. Print run 2,000,000

ISSUE.

The issue celebrates the centenary of the birth of Admiral Carlos Vegas Gago Coutinho, 1869-1959, explorer and aviation pioneer. The issue is a common type for all 7 colonies with the Angolan stamp showing Coutinho and his first ship. Design by Moura, and printed Litho Litografia Nacional, Oporto. Issued February 17.
